PRACTICUM AGROWIDYAWISATA (AGT-402) 2(0-2) CREDITS

Basic theory

Agrowidyawisata (AGT-402) 2(0-2) SKS (2015 curriculum) is one of the compulsory subjects in the Agroecotechnology Study Program, Faculty of Agriculture, UNIB. This means 2 practicum credits without any theoretical lectures. This course is held in the even semester of 2021/2022 (27 to 31 March 2022 to be precise). During the last 2 years during the Covid-19 pandemic, normal implementation was hampered, so several online lecture modifications were carried out in 2021. It was realized that the online method was not able to achieve the LO (learning Outcome) target of the Study Program. That's what has caused the accumulation of 2 batches taking this course (Class of 2019 and 2020).

In line with the slowing down of new cases of Covid-19 at the beginning of 2022, and the issuance of the Unib Chancellor's Circular Number 743/UN30/HK/2022 regarding Guidelines for Implementing Even Semester Lectures in 2021/2022 during the Covid-19 emergency response period at the University of Bengkulu. , then Agrowidyawisata lectures offline (offline) will immediately start again this even semester (January - June 2022 period). Tracing the history of the emergence of this course in the 2015 curriculum, it begins with a geographical story that this Study Program occupies an area on the west coast of the island of Sumatra. The students also come from the surrounding area. So it is deemed necessary to conduct some kind of effort so that these students are allowed to make a comparison of lectures in the AGROECOTECHNOLOGY STUDY PROGRAM IN HIGHER EDUCATIONS.

VISIT with lectures conducted at the Agroecotechnology Study Program at the Faculty of Agriculture, Bengkulu University. Furthermore, by making study visits to a university, participating students can see and feel the academic atmosphere, both within the scope of the Faculty of Agriculture and the University as a whole. Likewise, student study visits to GOVERNMENT & PRIVATE RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS, as well as MILLENIAL MODERN AGRICULTURAL BUSINESS

In other words, students are expected to be able to know and understand the role and/or function of these institutions in the development of science and knowledge to support the development of agriculture in Indonesia. After students see and interact with the leadership and staff of workers in the institution, it is hoped that the students participating in the Agrowidyawisata course will see firsthand the practice of technological innovation in the field, and inspiration in the preparation of research proposals, and can also be used to start an agribusiness business

after students graduate.

However, in this semester, we are still trying to fulfill the three points above. The destinations are universities that have the same study program, companies, or any form of millennial agricultural business today, especially in regional areas, as well as supporting destinations in West Sumatra and Lampung.

Destination

The objectives of the Agrowidyawisata course are for students to:

- 1) Can take comparisons of learning in the same study program at other universities.
- 2) Able to identify and directly see the implementation of the latest technological innovations currently applied in the field for the activities of modern millennial agriculture;
- 3) Open insight for students to start the preparation of research proposals for theses; and
- 4) Making Agrowidyawisata an inspiration to start a business, or work in the field after students have graduated.

After taking this course, students can get the following outcomes:

- 1) New enthusiasm and motivation to complete studies immediately.
- 2) A collection of the latest technological innovations that are currently applied in the field for the activities of a modern millennial farm,
- 3) Have a research proposal title that will be used as a thesis, and

Implementation

The general requirements for participating in the implementation of Agrowidyawisata include:

- 1) Fill out KRS who take Agrowidyawisata courses
- 2) Register by registering (receipt)
- 3) Show a vaccine certificate (at least the first vaccine)
- 4) Health certificate from the nearest health center doctor or hospital
- 5) Information letter of certain disease history (if there is a history of disease)

This Agrowidyawisata course will be implemented immediately in the Even Semester of 2021/2022, after UTS takes an allocation of 5-7 days in the field (Sunday 27 to Thursday 31 March 2022). The preparations have started from the end of January to March. The final report, presentation/exam/response will be held in May 2022 (before the UAS schedule). The detailed agro-tourism schedule is shown in Table 1 below.

In the implementation of Agrowidyawisata this time, each small group of students is guided by one supervisor. The function of the supervising lecturer is to ensure the implementation of Agrowidyawisata activities by what is mandated in the 2015 curriculum. The supervisors will provide consulting services, starting from Agrowidyawisata activities in each destination, providing guidance on the preparation of activity reports, and evaluating reports written by students participating in Agrowidyawisata as well as conduct an assessment of the students he supervises, based on the research component (Attached Assessment Form).

During the implementation of activities at each destination, students are required to make notes (fill in the logbook) of activities systematically which are known (initialized) by the Supervisor, at the end of the visit at each destination (done at the time the activity will start the next day/breakfast). The preparation of complete reports by students is given a time of 12 days, starting from the time the Agrowidyawisata group returns to campus (12 April 2022). During the preparation of the Agrowidyawisata activity report, students are required to consult with the Advisory Lecturer. The Complete Report is compiled based on the logbook of all destinations visited. The destination provinces, supervisors, and destinations to be visited are as follows:

Destination; describe what you want to achieve by making study visits, both to universities and government/private institutions engaged in agriculture. Outer; describe what outcomes are obtained after participating in Agrowidyawisata activities.

CHAPTER II. TIME AND PLACE FOR AGROWIDTOURISM

Writing Technique

1. Report written on HVS paper of at least 80 g, with A4. size
2. Typed using the letter "Arial" with a font size of "12". For the cover and title of CHAPTER/SUBCHAPTER can use a larger font size or in "Bold".
3. Spacing "1.5"
4. After obtaining approval from the Advisory Lecturer, the report is printed using the "RED" color book volume.
5. The report is made in 3 (three) copies, 1 exemplar for the student concerned, 1 exemplar for the Advisory Lecturer, and 1 example for archives in the BDP Department.
6. Soft Copy The complete final report including the attachments is made in the form of a PDF file with a size of less than 5MB, and the link on Google Drive is sent to the respective Advisory Lecturers, and the BDP Department (majorbdp@unib.ac.id).

EVALUATION

Agrowidyawisata is a compulsory subject with a weight of 2 (0-2) credits. All activities that are followed and carried out by students at the Agrowidyawisata place will be assessed by the Advisory Lecturer. The points that will be assessed by the Advisor include Attitude (politeness, ethics, appropriateness of dress) 10%, Discipline 10%, Activities during study visits 10%, Completeness of reports 35%, and Oral Response 35%.

A complete report that has been checked and signed by the Advisory Lecturer no later than 12 days after the end of the Agrowidyawisata activity, starting from the day of return/arrival in Bengkulu (1-12 April 2022), submitted to the Advisory Lecturer, and the BDP Department (Archive).

The schedule for the implementation of the assessment (presentation/exam/response) for Agrowidyawisata refers to Table 2 above regarding the schedule for the implementation of Agrowidyawisata.

ATTACHMENT

Appendix 1. Regulations for Agrowidyawisata Participants.

1. Wearing an alma mater coat during visits to agro-tourism destinations and wearing a mask.
2. Agrowidyawisata activity is a course with a credit weight of 2 (0-2) credits. This means that this course is the same as practicum, without any face-to-face theory. As a course, the academic rules for the Agrowidyawisata course are the same as the academic regulations for other courses in the Agroecotechnology Study Program. Dress modestly, don't drink alcohol, don't litter, and maintain a good attitude and behavior while in class, on buses, and in other public places.
3. Participants in the Agrowidyawisata course are required to bring 1 backpack and 1 suitcase.
4. Missing the bus is the full responsibility of Agrowidyawisata participants.
5. On the bus, students participating in Agrowidyawisata occupy seats as arranged (not allowed to change seats, except with the permission of the lecturer who accompanies them on the bus).
6. During the Agrowidyawisata trip, students are not allowed to change buses that are in the group.
7. While traveling by bus, you are not allowed to open your luggage to drop your luggage, except after arriving at the hotel/inn.
8. Backpacks filled with equipment used during field visits.
9. Keep order while resting at the hotel/inn.
10. When at the hotel it is strictly forbidden to chat and sit in the lobby/hallway of the hotel.
11. When breakfast at the hotel is strictly prohibited, do not finish/leave food that has been taken on the plate.
12. It is strictly forbidden to carry hotel inventory inside the hotel/inn and it is strictly forbidden to leave stains on hotel sheets and towels. If this is violated, sanctions will be given to students who occupy the room.
